## Several Chinese Investors Expected to Invest in Ethiopia: Ambassador Seyoum

Addis Ababa, February 5, 2012 (Addis Ababa) -Ambassador of Ethiopia to China Seyoum Mesfin said dozens of Chinese investors will come to Ethiopia soon to invest in the country.
